

Zuill Bailey's Custom Cufflinks for the Grammys

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When Zuill Bailey walks the red carpet for the Grammys on Sunday, he will be wearing a little bit of good luck from El Paso.

Local jeweler Susan Eisen designed and created the custom cufflinks. Eisen says she took small pieces of the Franklin Mountains, dipped them in gold and included a small diamond to signify the star on the mountain.

"We engraved on the back, 'Good Luck from El Paso,' Eisen said. "We're hoping that we can send all of these great vibes to Zuill so that he will be the winner. But, as I told him, he's already a winner in our book."

Eisen says this is the third year that she's designed jewelry for the Grammys.

As for Bailey, this is his first Grammy nomination for best solo classical performance. He's nominated for a total of three Grammys.
