- ▶ **The skinny:** Jewelry designer Susan Eisen's love for the city is no secret. For her gallery's annual "Heartbeat of El Paso," she joined photographer Jody Schwartz and glass artist Suzi Falsen in capturing the iconography of the area in some pretty imaginative ways. "People love buying things to be proud of El Paso. It's kind of a niche we've created with jewelry (and other art forms)," she says.
- ▶ **El Pasoness:** Obvious. Eisen bills it as a "collection of jewelry and art about El Paso, by El Pasoans." With photographs of mariachis, glass depictions of Scenic Drive and the UTEP logo, and jewelry, charms (imagine a gold taco!) and cutlery.
- ▶ **Where to get it:** The "Heartbeat of El Paso" collection ranges from \$30-\$3,000. It's on view through Dec. 31 at Susan Eisen Fine Jewelry & Watches, 5857 N. Mesa, Suite 19. Some proceeds will go to local charities.
